- 3) President's Report
 - a) Pool open May 16th
 - i) Board party Friday May 15th
 - b) 70 paid memberships right now, about 30 fewer than this time last year.
 - c) Inspection has passed
 - d) Pool looks great
 - i) All of the work that's been done looks great.
 - ii) Banners we have are hung. Waiting on a few more to get printed.
 - iii) House looks great, fantastic job cleaning up!
- 4) Committee Reports
 - a) Pool & Grounds – Chris Pinnix
 - i) Everything looks great. Fantastic teamwork for all that's been done.
 - ii) We look ready to open.
 - iii) Dana has done a fantastic job keeping the employees cleaning and prepping for the next day.
 - iv) Looks like we are good on trashcan placement.
 - v) We've got a new guy that will handle all the grounds work (mowing, etc.) for a banner and membership trade.
 - (1) Chris will chat with him this week to ensure this work is getting done right
 - vi) Try to remember to take the trash out from the grilling area after Fired Up Fridays.
 - b) Capital Projects – Open Seat
 - i) The entire team has pitched in on different aspects, and the place is looking great.
 - c) Website / Communications - Eric Fritz
 - i) With opening this weekend everyone needs to communicate dates and events so the web page can stay updated
 - ii) Currently it's \$8 a plate for two hot dogs or a hamburger, hot dog and a bag of chips.
 - iii) Last season we had the sign-up thing for sides from the board. Sounds like that was helpful for the board so Darren will try to recreate that.

- iv) Website traffic is down as compared to this time last year.
 - (1) Was around 300-400 hits, we're around 80 now as compared to last year.
 - (2) We did not hear back from the social media guy we had worked with the last time, so we haven't had any type of targeted push
- v) Rain date for the Saturday Memorial Day party will be Monday if needed
- d) Swim Team - Erin Caulder
 - i) First practice is May 18th with parents meeting
 - ii) First meet is Town and Country June 2nd
 - iii) Second meet is Brookwood June 9th
 - iv) Jonestown is the 3rd and finally home meet June 16th
 - v) Met with coaches and they seem excited and ready
 - (1) Registered as of last week only 20-25 swimmers, so that's low just like memberships.
 - (2) 55 swimmers is the ideal number.
 - vi) Planning a bit of a push at the ice cream social pool opening this Saturday.
 - vii) Erin will be out of town prior to that first swim meet due to family obligations.
 - viii) Sign up on Swimtopia for volunteers for serving and such at the meets.
 - (1) Grills are covered
- e) Employees - Dana Wagner
 - i) I've completed and sent out week 1's schedule for employees. We will continue to keep open and close each day and the same on weekends...only 1 guard at this time on the weekends (instead of staging with 2 during our busy time) due to low membership. We will continue to monitor and change as necessary.
 - ii) While school is still in session until May 27th, Nick is helping by opening the pool at 11am during the week and we'll have a guard starting at 4pm
 - iii) Brookstown summer camp will be utilizing the pool on Wednesdays from 10-12.
 - iv) If we amend our lifeguard coverage, such as down from 3 to 1 on peak days, that would cut hours and allow us to pay more.
- f) Programs – Open Seat
 - i) We will need to teamwork this.
 - ii) Darren will handle getting the food for Memorial Day
 - iii) DJ Steve is on board for parties.
 - iv) We'll just need to set up tables and such before the party
- 5) Treasurer's Report – Scott Cumming
 - a) Insurance coverage is nearly squared away and about done prior to renewal.
 - b) Expecting Richard's bill, which will include the chemicals. That will be a hefty bill.
 - c) For what we charge for membership as compared to our bills we are losing money, carrying stuff on a credit card at the end of the season to keep things going.

- i) If we want to increase anything, like lifeguard pay, we will be forced to raise prices.
 - d) Very little spent on improvements this year, so we have done good controlling that.
 - e) Biggest expenses are employees, which is only guards and desk workers. Second is water and power bills. Chemical bills cost us as well.
- 6) New Business
 - a) Dylan knows the folks at Old Town gym to see if they would like to set up a program just like Brookstown does.
 - i) \$5 per head is what we charge Brookstown, which is 50% of the regular guest fee.
 - ii) Tuesday mornings are the best due to no swim practice
 - b) Don't forget the board party. No guest fees for board members for this one night only.
